

## The Global Citizenship Programme

Education is our core focus as a charity and so our mission in the UK is to educate, empower and inspire students by opening up their learning on a global scale. *Education is a powerful gift that can change the world we live in!*

We run a Global Citizenship Programme in schools all over the UK designed to do just this, opening up conversations about poverty, culture, community, global issues and the importance of compassion and citizenship.

We partner with primary schools, secondary schools and colleges who are passionate about promoting, exploring and exercising their roles as global citizens, broadening their pupils understanding of the world, and providing staff and students with the opportunities to make a difference.



## How does it work?

Our Global Citizenship Programme works like this:

- ◀ **E** ***We visit your school and deliver assemblies, workshops and lessons***
  - These assemblies, workshops and lessons are designed to tackle specific issues that the communities in our international projects face.
  
- ◀ **E** ***You get access to our educational resource library***
  - Each resource links in the with United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, and is suitable from KS1-KS5. Our resources are designed to educate students on an array of global issues and tackles the injustices that some children face.
  - Each resource is accompanied by real life stories, case studies and videos of children from our international projects. These videos provide those children abroad with a voice to talk about issues as they see them
  - The resource library will have a constant flow of new resources being uploaded meaning you'll never be short of a lesson!
  
- ◀ **E** ***Support a child's education***
  - We look to empower students to be a part of the solution to poverty, which we believe is education. Supporting a child through education allows your students to react to the themes they have learn about through assemblies and resources.
  - Your school can follow the journey of the children abroad that you support, you will receive regular updates about their school life.
  - We make sure that it is a two-way relationship! You can send messages to the children you support, and they can send messages back to your school
  - Edukid looks to provide live ZOOM links between your school, and the school the children you support attend.
  
- ◀ **E** ***We provide Student Council support***
  - Student led fundraising is an important part of actively exercising Global Citizenship. We meet with your student council to offer fundraising ideas

and guidance that will help them to raise money for the children your school supports abroad.

### ◀ **E** *Your staff and students can come on trips to our international projects!*

- Staff and students in year 10 and above will have the opportunity to visit our international projects
- share cultures, teach each other and build relationships
- connect with the communities and form friendships with the children you support!

### ◀ **E** *Visits from abroad*

- Have former Edukid students who have finished their education travel over to the UK and visit your school in order to share stories about their lives, and how gaining an education has impacted them.

### ◀ **E** *The Global Citizenship awards scheme*
